Examination of November 17, 1974

The following pages present a list of candidates eligible for the position of Sergeant, arranged in order of their total accumulated promotional score. All candidates listed have passed the promotional examination and are hereby certified to be qualified and eligible for promotion when they comply with the additional criteria that follows.

In order to be promoted candidates must meet the college credit requirement detailed in Personnel Order 73-360; i.e., possess 30 quarter hours or 20 semester hours of properly accredited college course work, or, be covered by the seniority provision as set forth in the grandfather clause. A further requisite for promotion is completion of the Officer Candidate School with a passing score.

Individual officers who have not validated college credits in the promotional process and who are not eligible pursuant to the grandfather clause will be contacted to make arrangements to present evidence that they comply with Personnel Orders 73-360 and 74-270. Those officers who have not met the college credit requirement when their name comes up for promotion will be passed over. However, they will retain their position on the register and have the opportunity to meet the requirement during the life of the register.

All candidates will be screened to determine if they are in compliance with residency standards as described by City Ordinance, Department Rules and Regulations and Collective Bargaining Agreements. Officers who do not pass this screen will not be promoted and their names will be dropped from the promotional register.

Candidates will be promoted in accordance with the needs of the Department as determined by the Chief of Police and affirmative action principles supported by City Charter, Board of Police Commissioners, and the Department Policy Statement published on Notation 74-25.

Officers promoted must successfully complete a one year probationary period before they will be confirmed in rank.

The expiration date for this register is June 30, 1976.
