In their meeting of January 13, 1975, the Region Seven Board of Education approved a resolution requesting you to work with the Detroit Police Department to achieve immediate response in case of emergency at one of our schools.

They also approved a motion to request that police officers that you contemplate assigning to schools be assigned instead to the precincts with the sole responsibility of servicing schools. In the opinion of the Board this would provide not only greater flexibility but greater effectiveness in responding to emergency situations.
