On the above time & date I, Pat. Richard Worber was standing on the Southwest corner of John R + Belmont holding a gas can in my hand leaning against a pole. I was approached by two negro males, def #1 about 5-9 160 lbs, def #2 about 5-8, 150 lbs. Def #1 was holding a steel rod about 18" in length + red in color in ~~his~~ right hand. He approached me + said "The man what's happening? are you lost brother?" at this time he jabbed me in the gut with the steel rod. Def #2 at this time grabbed my right arm while #1 dropped the rod + began to remove my watch from my left hand. After def #1 grabbed my right

DETAILS: (Continued) arm he said "GIVE IT UP." Both
men began to kick & hit me forcing me down
to one knee. at this time I identified myself
as a police officer & ordered the men to halt. Both
men continued to assault me. I again ordered them
to halt & again identified myself as a P.O. When the
men continued to assault me I drew my personally owned
dept approved .38 Cal 6 Shot Colt Cobra serial #

[REDACTED] at this point both men began to escape I
again yelled "HALT POLICE." When the men did not
stop I fired 2 shots at def #1, the shots did not
appear to take effect, def #1 at this time was running
South East on John R. Def #2 was running NW on
Belmont. After firing at def #1 I turned & fired one
shot at def #2 it did not appear to take effect I
fired a second shot. I did not see def #2 fall, he
ran up to parked cars on the street & disappeared. at
this time I turned back towards def #1 & fired 2
shots. Def #1 continued to run, he crossed JOHN R &
fell on the sidewalk on the E. side of the street. I
then went up to def #1 he was lying face down bleeding
from the back & the mouth.

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DETAILS: Also he was moaning. I then called for assistance to convey def #1 to the hospital. Scout 138 arrived about 2 min later. When they picked def #1 up to put him on the stretcher the watch he had stolen from me dropped to the ground. The watch was placed on E.T. 992427. The steel pipe was found on the ground where def #1 had dropped it on the corner of John R & Belmont & placed it on E.T. 992428.

After def #1 was conveyed to [redacted] Patr MAZZONI & myself began to search the area for def #2. We got in an unmarked scout car & drove around the area. When we got back to the original scene of the robbery & assault we noticed a crowd gathered around a parked car on the N. side of Belmont facing
