Brief Analytical Summary

- A-1. The Delinquent Caseload increased from 10/85 through 12/86 by 34 or 1%. P.A. 150 wards followed the same rise by 54 or 2%. Court wards continued to increase from 10/85 through 12/86 by 82 or 17%.
- A-2. As of 12/31/86, Wayne County has 52% of the P.A. 150 wards (Wayne County has no court wards) and 41% of the total Delinquent caseload.
- A-3. As of 12/31/86, 2 of the counties that had 10 or more court wards as of 6/30/85 had less than 10 court wards.
In these 10 counties court wards increased by 62 or 22% as of 12/31/86.
State wards in these counties decreased.
- A-4. As of 12/31/86, Black Delinquent wards constituted 44% of the statewide delinquency caseload with 46% of the Black delinquents being males. Black wards constituted 20% of the outstate delinquency caseload and 68% of the Wayne County caseload.
- B-1. During the first quarter of FY 87 Commitments in Wayne County exceeded outstate commitments by 25 or 19%.
- B-2. The MDSS Wayne County Probate Court Commitment Agreement states that during a given year the court will commit no more than 480 wards to MDSS an average of 40/month. From 6/86 through 12/86, Wayne County CYS has accepted 309 new commitments an average of 51 per month. The total commitments accepted for the calendar year 1986 was 621.
- C-1. The percent of the delinquency caseload placed in campus (high) and community (medium) structured placements continues to increase, since 10/81 through 12/86 the percent of caseloads in campus high increased from 30.3% to 40%. Medium structured placements increased also - from 9.8% to 12% during this period
The percent of the workers caseload in a permanency placement, i.e. own home, independent living, etc. has decreased from 41.5% to 31% since 10/81.
- D-1. As of 12/31/86, 23.2% of the state wards committed a Felony Against Persons. This offense pattern increased since 10/81 by 53 or 9%.
- D-2. As of 12/31/86, 18.8% of the state wards outstate, committed a Felony Against Persons. This offense pattern decreased since 10/81 by 12 or 4%.
- D-3. As of 12/31/86, 28% of the state wards, Wayne Co. committed a Felony Against Persons. This offense pattern increased since 10/81 by 65 or 21%.
..Status offenders decreased during this period, statewide, by 465 or 48%.
..Felony against property decreased during this period, statewide, by 571 or 35%.
..Misdemeanor offenses remained about the same during this period.

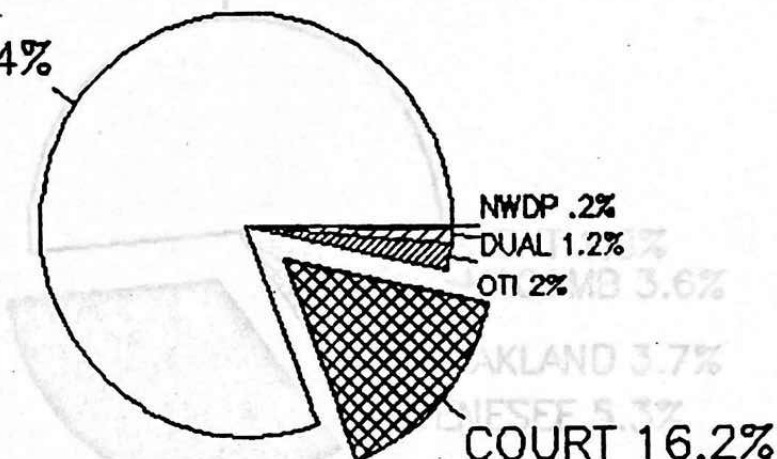
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DELINQUENCY CASELOAD BY LEGAL STATUS

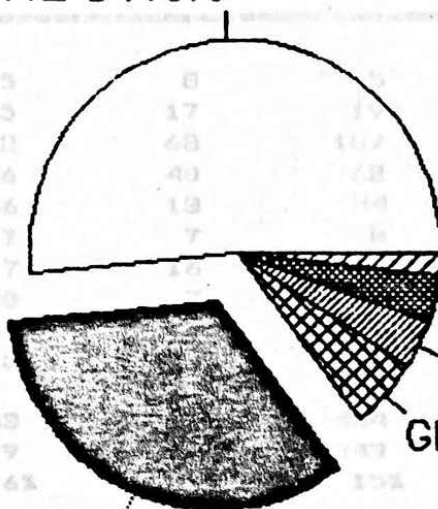
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DELINQUENCY CASELOAD BY AREA

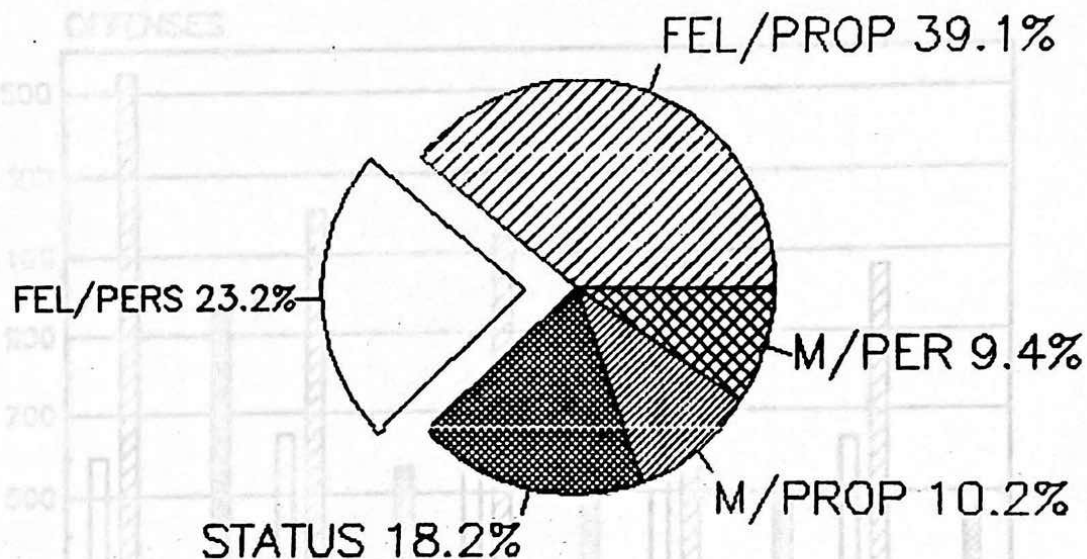

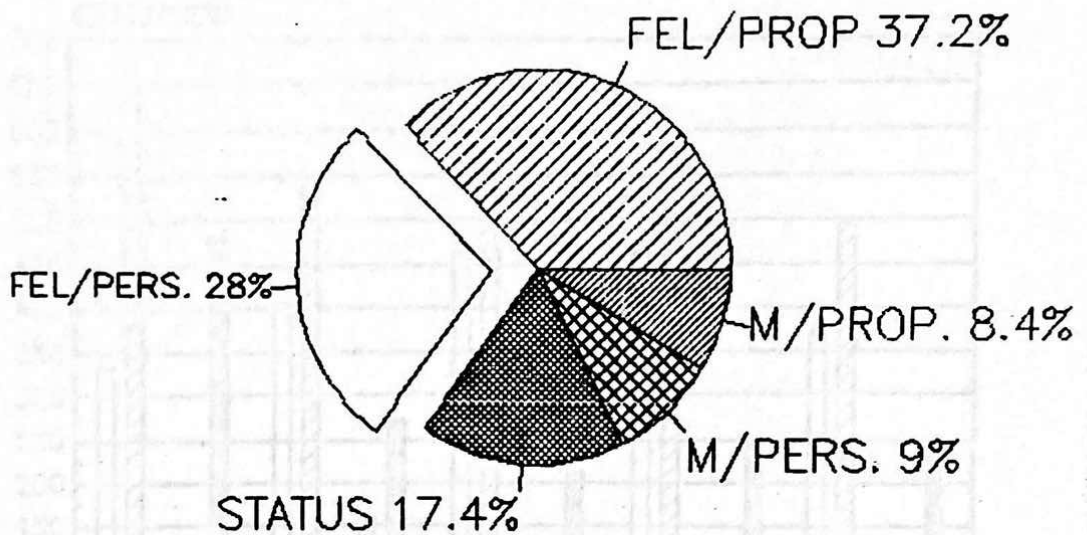

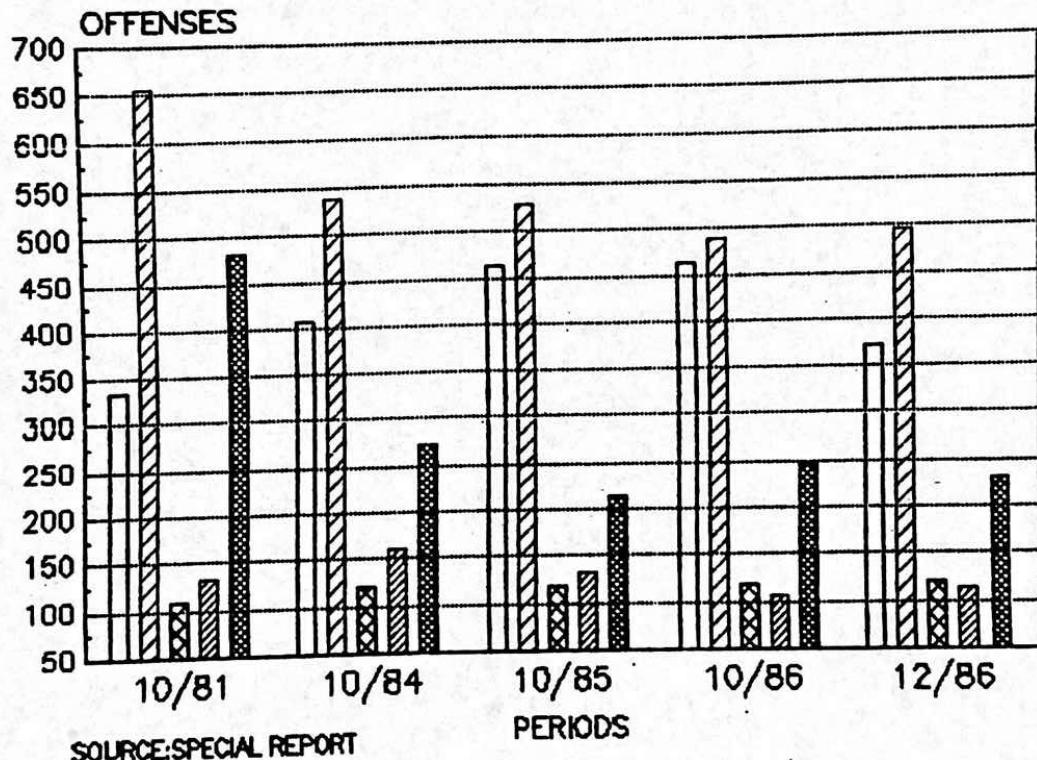
