Dear Mayor Young:

Subject: Warrant request submitted to the Wayne County Prosecutors Office by this Department on eight police officers assigned to the Tenth Precinct.

This memorandum is to inform you that a warrant request has been submitted to the Wayne County Prosecutors Office against eight (8) police officers assigned to the Tenth Precinct. In brief, the warrant request details the improper execution of a narcotics raid by uniformed officers assigned to the Tenth Precinct on the premises of 6411-15 Tuxedo, in the City of Detroit on February 21, 1988. Additionally, the officers forced the citizen to ingest several rocks of suspected cocaine. This action resulted in Emergency Medical Services (EMS) having to convey the complainant to the hospital. It is also alleged that the officers took money and a gun from the premises.

The Prosecutors Office is also considering the feasibility of charging the officers in a second and unrelated unlawful entry which occurred on February 21, 1988 at 5001 Dailey. In this incident, the officers allegedly raided the upper and lower flats of a two family flat and stole money.
