SUMMARY OF COMPLAINT: Subject states that on July 30, 1966, around 3:00 P. M. in the afternoon, some police officers came into the subject's gas station looking for some lottery tickets(numbers). The officers did not find any tickets so they went into the cash register and removed all of the cash that was in the register. Subject and 13 men and 4 women were taken to 1300 Beaubien Police Station and locked up from Saturday, July 30, 1966 until Monday, August 1, 1966. Subject court date was set for August 25, but he did not receive his money back. Subject was falsely arrested because he did not have any numbers on his person and none of the other people had any in their possession. Subject states that he was harassed and discriminated against.
