SUMMARY OF COMPLAINT: Subject states that on August 22, 1966, around 1:30 P. M., her son, Joseph Dunbar, 14 years old was riding in a stolen car with a young boy name Reggie ? on Lawton and Glynn Court. The police in the Tactical Mobile Unit stopped the boys and told them to get out of the car. The boys got out of the car and the officers handcuffed the boys and put them into the scout car. Enroute to the police station, Joseph Dunbar was beaten so severely by one of the officer's in the Tactical Mobile Unit car he was unconscious when he was taken to Receiving Hospital. Joseph was hit in the head several times with a sharp object. Joseph had continuous seizures in the hospital and is on the critical list. Mrs. Brayboy states that her son
