

Injured Trying To 'Even Score' With Policeman

A 20-year-old man was injured and held for assault and battery on a police officer after he led police on a chase through several alleys and struck one officer.

Kendall Cade, 4940 Bangor, was taken to Detroit General hospital in temporary serious condition with a laceration to the head.

When observed by officers parked in an alley, Cade had sped off and made several turns in an attempt to elude officers before stopping at the rear of his home.

Officers said he refused to show identification, opened his garage door and walked in, stating he was getting something to "even the score." As one patrolman approached him, Cade reportedly swung, striking the patrolman.

Another patrolman was said to have assisted the first officer in subduing Cade, who was injured in the scuffle.
