**STIPULATION AND ORDER TO DISMISS THE CONDITIONS OF
CONFINEMENT CONSENT JUDGMENT**

On October 28, 2013, the Detroit Police Department transferred custody of all of its pre-arraignment detainees to the Michigan Department of Corrections, Detroit Detention Facility. Prior to that date, the Detroit Police Department had achieved 100% compliance with all paragraphs of the Conditions of Confinement Consent Judgment, which had a termination date of July 18, 2013. For these reasons, the parties agree that the Conditions of Confinement Consent Judgment should be dismissed, and the Independent Monitor has

submitted a report indicating his concurrence. See Attachment A (December 11, 2013 "Tour of MDOC Detention Facilities).
