\*Hertha did not really respond to the student demands and refused to answer questions from students.


\*We see no evidence of work being done on any of the student demands. Hertha has had since February to implement demand #10, and nothing has been done.

# Unite Or Perish!

1. We demand that the books in the school library be more relevant in that they contain material relevant to the lives of Black Students.
2. We demand that the text books be changed to meet the needs of Black students.
3. We demand that the curriculums be changed to suit the needs of Black students goals in life.
4. We demand the expansion of the Reading Room and Clinic to bring up to par the reading levels of the majority of students who can't read.
5. We demand the placement of students in Data Processing and Keypunch classes so they won't close.
6. We demand the opening of lavatories so that students' biological needs can be taken care of without having to go to another floor.
7. We demand the opening of Exit and Entrance doors so that in the event of a fire or some other emergency students won't have to panic and run to other doors that may or not be open.
8. We demand that the music taught reflect Black existence and Black artists.
9. We demand that remedial math classes be taught since over 50% of the student body is now failing math.
10. We demand the removal of all police, uniformed, un-uniformed, private and public from Central, IMMEDIATELY! And the adoption of the Student Hall Guard Plan under the direction of the Afro-Club.

11. We demand that the English Department remove its emphasis from white-European oriented culture and writers and begin to deal with contemporary authors.
12. We demand the end to the harrassment of the Afro-Club.
13. We demand the end to harrassment of the Black Student League and its publication the Central High Black Student Voice.
14. We demand the abolishment of the Student Council and the Student Cabinet because they fail to meet the needs of students and aren't needed if they aren't doing anything.
15. We demand that the Board of Education contract Black workers and businessmen to repair the school and its grounds.
16. We demand the removal of all white pictures from the school walls and that they be replaced with pictures of Black heroes. (Malcolm X, Marcus Garvey, etc.)
17. We demand the establishment of a community student review board that will select, approve, and evaluate all faculty members and school administrators.
