Now comes WILLIS W. CHAPMAN Plaintiff herein, and in this his complaint against the DETROIT POLICE DEPARTMENT for not releasing guns, respectfully shows unto this HONORABLE COURT as follows:

1. That he was the resident at 8375 Esper Blvd. in the City of DETROIT, COUNTY OF WAYNE, STATE OF MICHIGAN

2. That he was arrested at 1:15 pm on the 29 June 1978, by officers from the 6th precinct, handcuffed and put in a police car because of plaintiff shooting a gun in his house

3. That approximately 15 to 20 police officers searched plaintiff house without a search-warrant

4. That the arresting officers confiscated a shotgun which had not been fired, a p-38 pistol which had been fired, during the eviction proceedings conducted by a officer of the COMMON PLEAS COURT, LANDLORD TENANT DIVISION, CITY OF DETROIT, bailiff JAMES KINNARD, case no. 1301478, the p38 is a 2nd. world war souvenir and a antique, a gun collector's item, and its price-less to plaintiff

5. That plaintiff was finger printed at 3:30 pm and charged with FELONIOUS ASSULT

6. That plaintiff was again finger printed at 5:15 pm, but was not told why

7. That plaintiff was told his rights at 5:30 pm, which was 4½ hours after his arrest by the officer who drove him to DETROIT POLICE HEAD-QUARTERS

8. That plaintiff was again finger-printed at Detroit Police Headquarters and still not told why

9. That plaintiff was read his right at 10:00 pm on the 29 June 1978 by a Detective, who made reference to a police record dated 1956

10. That plaintiff prays this HORONABLE COURT, expunge his police records, which is 23 years old

11. That the police must inform plaintiff of his rights at the time of his arrest

12. That the criminal rights 1966 case of MIRANDA VS ARIZONA, 1966, 384 U.S. 436, 166 ED 2d, 694, 86 S ct 1602, 10 ALR 3d 974, the SUPREME COURT held

13. That police are required to warn criminal suspect, as soon as they are taken into custody, of the right to remain silent, this was not done according to the FEDERAL CRIMINAL PROCEDURE RULE #5 (a) 44

14. That the requiring of a commitment ( charge) without unnecessary delay

15. That plaintiff was released at 10:30 pm, and charges dropped

16. That upon this, plaintiff requested COMMANDER JOHN TSAMPIKO of the SUPPORT DIVISION to release guns: EXAMPLE "A" AFFIDAVIT (MAILGRAM)

WHEREFORE, PLAINTIFF PRAYS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That this excludes from trials evidence that has been obtained illegally, plaintiff guns
2. That this was illegal search and seizure
3. That there was no search warrant issued, for the searching of plaintiff house
4. That the DETROIT POLICE DEPARTMENT release plaintiff guns
5. That the expungeing of plaintiff police record
6. That plaintiff may have such other relief as plaintiff believe is fair and just also that plaintiff be granted its cost and the equivalent of Attorney's fees
