Dear Lieutenant Hady:

Re: Detroit Police Mini-Station

Confirming our telephone conversation of recent date, we are sincerely interested in locating one of your mini-stations in our Detroit terminal.

While I recognize the pressures you receive from various individuals and organizations each expressing reasons for the need for such a facility in their immediate location or area, I would certainly like for our Detroit Greyhound terminal to be given serious consideration for the location of such a facility for the following reasons.

First of all, this terminal is a quasi "public place," in that the very nature of our business is such that it is impossible for us to screen those who would enter upon these premises as to the legitimacy of their doing so. We are one of the few business enterprises that are open 24 hours per day thus making it an attractive location for people to congregate when other places in the vicinity close.

Also, the nature of our business is such that to many persons it is their first glimpse of the City of Detroit particularly those travelers who are coming into the city on business or for a visit. It also serves as a "window" looking out upon your city to those many travelers whose journeys route them through Detroit.

It is my feeling that the mere presence of one of your facilities on the premises would do much to enhance the image of the city by creating a greater sense of security on the part of those travelers using public transportation.

We are very desirous of cooperating with you in making the necessary space available and would even consider a monetary contribution, if necessary to enable such an arrangement to become a reality.
