

Policemen Injured in Arrest Try

Three policemen were injured Tuesday as they sought to apprehend a man who had escaped after being arrested before.

Patrolmen Roland Anderson, 29, Robert Krichke, 25, and Michael Tomlinson, 25, all members of the newly-formed Tactical Mobil Unit, were injured when they attempted to arrest Wesley Heard, 25, of 582 Watson.

Heard had been arrested for robbery armed with two other men and had walked away from the 13th precinct while the others were being registered.

Members of the TMU went to the Watson street address and saw Heard jump from a second story window and apprehended him. The officers were injured in the struggle that followed.

Heard was taken to Detroit General Hospital (Receiving) suffering from multiple contusions to the head and face.
