SUMMARY OF COMPLAINT: Subject states that her son Sam Jones was arrested, Saturday, July 16, 1966 for suspicion of stealing a car. Sam was beaten so severely that he was unconscious when he was taken to the county jail. The police officers who took the subject's son, Sam to the county jail denies that they struck Sam. When subject went down to the county jail to try and see her son, she was denied the privilege and told that he was not allowed to receive visitors. Sam has been a patient at the Ionia State Hospital for the mentally disturbed. Subject states that she wants the case investigated.
