It was my understanding that when I agreed to be a Plaintiff in the litigation against the Wayne County Sheriff and the Board of Commissioners, that there would be no Punishments of any kind for my Participation. Well that is not so. I am being Punished.

I have three sisters. All of my life we have been pretty close. They have been coming to the jail to see me regularly - until recently. Now, neither one of them have been to see me since December 20, 1971. I have repeatedly written them asking them what is wrong. I have received no answers. Previous to the above date, they came to the jail to see me but was told for various reasons one of them told her I was being Punished.

I did not know I was under punishment. Since I believe that they are coming to see me, and that the officials here are not letting them up, and since I have repeatedly wrote to them without receiving any answers, I can only conclude that my letters are not being mailed. Could you have a check on this, and let me know what is wrong. My visits days are on Mondays every two weeks, or during the first and third weeks.
