

Professor Norman Pollock gave one of the longest speeches of the afternoon, reading from notes, about the historical significance of a nation such as the U.S. entering a foreign nation and telling that nation how to run its affairs. He was against the war and against the effort to take American men into Vietnam to fight against the people who have the right to determine the running of their nation.
