

1           there's a reasonable basis of mediation that can  
2           occur.

3                           And so within that context I'm  
4           concerned about whether or not the stopping of  
5           individuals and the Court has held too that  
6           extremely randomized activity First and Fourth  
7           Amendment, needs to be clarified because if it's  
8           too randomized it can essentially encroach upon  
9           the rights of citizens to have a reasonable  
10          expectation of privacy.

11                          Also the City Council passed a law -- I  
12          mean passed an ordinance in terms of the  
13          anti-racial profiling ordinance, Councilman  
14          Cockrel did, some time ago and I think we need to  
15          take a look at this.

16                          I'm not questioning the motives, but  
17          I'm questioning the institution of the process  
18          because if everyone who has a cracked windshield  
19          or excessive smoke or whatever is stopped, you're  
20          going to have the jails full and you're going to  
21          have some questions about the reasonable  
22          expectation of privacy.

23                          And I might add, running up on someone  
24          and saying, "Where are the drugs and where are  
25          the guns?" when they're leaving to go to lunch
