A Conant Gardens housewife asserted this week she was ignored by Highland Park police officers after seeking assistance following an accident.

Mrs. Kenneth Hutchins, 38, of 4015 Nevada, said she fell on slippery pavement while shopping in Highland Park Friday and severely injured herself. She stopped a police car and asked for help.

Mrs. Hutchins said the two officers in the car told her they would send another car to help her.

Police officials in Highland Park said the two officers were on a dispatched run and came directly to the station, where they reported the incident to their immediate superior.

The official said "We were busy that day and the possibility exists that the Sergeant who received the information could have forgotten about it in the overall hustle and bustle of the station."

He stated that it "certainly is not the policy of this department to have such things happen."

The Sergeant in question was not available for comment.
