Subject states that on June 3, 1966 around 2:30 P.M. she was preparing to get ready to go to the hospital with her son Eli. Eli went downstairs of the home to wait for his mother. A young boy by the name of David Austin called the subject and told her that her son said to come downstairs. When subject got downstairs, next door to her home the police were on the front porch and had her son, Clarence Vester down on the porch beating him. There were about three policemen on top of the boy. They had hit him in the head with the blackjack about seven or eight times. His head was bleeding badly. Mrs. Vester asked, "what was wrong"? The police told her to shut up and get back. Subject states that she told the police that she was the boy's mother and what had he done? The police replied that he did not care who she was and for her to mind her business. One of the police officers pushed her and she had to catch the post on the porch to keep from falling off of the porch. Subject claims that she was hurt and had to go to the doctor that same night. in the car and said that they were going to come back and kill all of those niggers.
