Dear Sir:

This letter is to call your attention to the recent incidents and the atrocious murder of Cynthis Scott, and Kenneth Evans by law enforcement officers.

Detroit can no longer tolerate the complacency and many injustices suffered at the hands of those who are charged with law enforcement. This we feel violates all principles of decency and justice.

As prosecutor for the City of Detroit, you have a direct and specific responsibility to see that such inhuman and unjust treatment of its citizens is brought to an end.

It is inconceivable that you can sit and watch these vile and vicious acts that are detrimental and demoralizing to the citizens of Detroit, and the world.

While the world is aghast at the chain of events happening in the deep South, in its inhuman treatment of individuals, attention is also being focused on the North because of such incidents as these.

We further realize that no one can legislate morals, but we do know that the citizens of Detroit will remember the officers that were discharged with integrity and dignity when we go to the polls again.
