RE: Federal Drug Omnibus Act of 1986
DATE: February 18, 1987

As a result of the enactment of the above-referenced Act, the State of Michigan will be receiving approximately \$20 million for the education, prevention, treatment, and criminal justice aspects of the abuse, use, and sale of drugs.

The Act approves funding for three years but is only appropriated for FY 87. We are designing our programs and processes with this drug money as if the money will not be appropriated for FY 88 and 89.

The Act divides the monies into three categories and is allocated as follows by federal guidelines:

Office of Substance Abuse Services	\$6-8 million
Department of Education	\$6,179,812
Office of Criminal Justice	\$6,141,000

THE OFFICE OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Money is distributed on an allocation formula basis with a portion of treatment and attention given to DSS Children and Youth Services for pre-school children, adaptation of the Michigan Model in detention facilities, and in-patient services for ADC/GA recipients.

EDUCATION MONEY

Seventy percent (approximately \$4,325,867) shall be used by the Department of Education to make grants to local and intermediate school districts, allocated as follows:
