Major Assaultive Crimes Targeted By HB 4057

Jurisdiction would be extended for all listed crimes.
The presumptive waiver would apply only to the shorter indented list.

Crime and Maximum Imprisonment

72	Burning dwelling house (arson) - 20 years.
73	Burning of other real property (willful) - 10 years.
83	Assault with intent to commit murder - life.
84	Assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than murder - 10 years.
86	Assault with intent to maim - 10 years.
88	Assault with intent to rob and steal being unarmed - 15 yrs.
89	Assault with intent to rob and steal being armed - life.
91	Attempt to murder - life.
136a	Torturing of children - 10 years.
316*	First degree murder - mandatory life without parole.
317*	Second degree murder - life.
349	Kidnaping - life.
520b*	First degree criminal sexual conduct - life.
520c	Second degree criminal sexual conduct - 15 years.
520d*	Third degree criminal sexual conduct - 15 years.
520g	Assault with intent to commit criminal sexual conduct - 10 years or 5 years.
529*	Armed robbery; aggravated assault - life.
530	Unarmed robbery - 15 years.

* Probation is prohibited for these offenses, for treason, and for major controlled substance offenses. MCL 771.1.

Note: Similar lists have included MCL 750.82 (felonious assault - 4 years) and MCL 750.227b (felony firearm - flat 2 years for first offense, 5 years for second, and 10 years for third). Either could result in a juvenile being incarcerated for longer than an adult could be, hence their exclusion here.
