Francis A. Kornegay, Executive Director of the Detroit Urban League, today said that the investigation into STRESS should not end with the exoneration of one police officer.

He said that the Urban League supports the concept and need for STRESS. While the force is doing an apparently effective job of reducing crime in the streets, many questions still need to be answered.

"We need to find out who is assigned to the force, what his special qualifications must be and what special instructions he is given when he joins STRESS." "Moreover, what instructions are given, when to use force, what kind and to what degree," Kornegay said.

He urged a study come forward with answers to these questions but said that meanwhile the force should continue to operate.
