

POLICEMAN, WOMAN INJURED

Arrest Four Youths In Knifing, Theft

Police arrested four youths early Tuesday for an east-side breaking and entering after one youth reportedly informed police of the others' whereabouts. A patrolman and a youth both claimed injuries, and the robbery victim said she had been cut.

Held for armed robbery were Johnny Johnson, 22, 8149 Holcomb; Maurice Thompson, 17, Eddie Gardner, 17, and James Smith, 19, all of 4245 Mt. Elliott.

Patrolman Frank Tuljus said he had been injured when Johnson resisted arrest, and Johnson said the officer had hurt his neck and back.

Police were alerted to the alleged breaking and entering when they observed Johnson jumping off the porch at 1196 E. Grand Blvd.

Patrolman Tuljus apprehended Johnson, and both men were conveyed to the hospital.

At the scene, officers found the glass in the rear of the Boulevard address broken out and the door standing open. Irene Snider, 77, reportedly told them she had been awakened by the sound of breaking glass when three men entered her bedroom.

She said one thug held a knife to her throat and threatened to kill her if she did not give them money. She said when this thug cut her on the forehead and arm with either a knife or letter opener, she gave them \$30 from a dresser drawer.

She also told police the thugs had ransacked all the rooms in the house, and had placed a radio, three fur coats and other items on a table when they were apparently frightened away by the officers' approach.

Acting on information received from Johnson, police later went to 4245 Mt. Elliott where they were ad-

mitted by Smith and found Thompson under a bed and arrested Gardner hiding on the roof.
